

Community Care Recruitment and Practice Start-up Programs

Initiatives of CCNC's Center for Community-Based Primary Care and CCPN launching in January 2025

Community Care Physician Network (CCPN) and Community Care of North Carolina (CCNC) recognize primary care's critical role in ensuring healthy communities. We want to support a robust primary care delivery system across our state, especially in our most rural and vulnerable communities.

CCNC's Center for Community Based Primary Care is creating the **Community Care Recruitment** and **Practice Start-Up Programs** to positively impact a primary care workforce pipeline.

The Community Care Recruitment Program

This program is aimed at residents specializing in family medicine, pediatrics or general internal medicine willing to commit to practice in an independent CCPN practice. The program is also open to Family Nurse Practitioners (NPs) and Physician Assistants (PAs) serving as communitybased primary care clinicians, as we understand their value to the primary care delivery system.

Practice Start-up Program

The Center also recognizes that starting a new primary care practice can appear daunting to newly licensed physicians and so the Community Care Practice Start-up Program has been created to support clinicians seeking to start their own independent CCPN practice. Requests will be assessed and funded on an individual, case-by-case basis.

The **Community Care Recruitment Program** will provide unrestricted funds to incentivize eligible primary care clinicians to practice in a CCPN practice serving vulnerable populations, including Medicaid and Medicare beneficiaries.

- Provide a Physician Scholarship of up to \$150,000 with an additional \$20,000 for practicing in a region with an HPSA score higher than 14. The funds will be distributed at \$30,000 a year for five years.
- Target students in the second and third year of Family Medicine, Pediatric or General Internal Medicine Residency Programs.
- Require a commitment to practice in a CCPN practice and participate in the Center's Venture Mentorship Program.
- Link all recipients to a dedicated team of experienced physicians and community business leaders to mentor them in their journey into community based primary care.
- Provide a NP/PA Scholarship of \$60,000, with an additional \$5,000 for practicing in a region with an HPSA score higher than 14. Funds of \$12,000 a year for five years will be distributed upon graduation and employment in a CCPN practice.
